Roundtable:

- HIGHWAY – 42 trips for this season for snow removal. Tree work on Waterford has been completed and will be going to Sherwood as well as work on Erie St. Highway Superintendent stated that he has received a few quotes for generators and will forward that to the Board.
- POLICE – will be sending two recruits to the Police Academy in March. The Police Chief stated that he received a grant through Walmart and to get 8 new vests. Crime and activity are down or have slowed down a bit. Councilman Maul asked what the process is that you let the potential candidates know that you have picked other candidates. The Chief stated that they will let each candidate know.
- RECREATION – wanted to give an update on programs started. Pee Wee Soccer at the Pal-mac Intermediate School last year there were 12 participants and this year there were 70 participants which may have exceeded the amount allowed at the school. Had an adult cooking class at the middle school. If we offer this class again, we may need to look for another space if we have more participants sign up as the space would not be big enough. The Easter Egg hunt will be Saturday, March 25<sup>th</sup> at the Town Complex. Spring soccer registration will be open next be starting soon. Summer Camp is underway and will be from July 5, 2023 – August 11, 2023, and possibly an additional week from August 11, 2023 – August 18, 2023, as well as looking to change the hours to 7:30-5:00.
- SUPERVISOR – had a couple of residents asking about the Tentative Telecommunications collections and will be meeting with the Assessor.
- Councilman Maul stated that he has reached out to the credit card processing for the recreation credit card payments and they are in the process to switch over to the new bank account.
- PUBLIC – A resident asked about the Public Safety Building regarding a generator and if anyone has talked to the energy companies regarding the infrastructure on that side of town. The last day to receive proposals for the Master Plan and the Town Clerk stated that the Town had received 6 proposals.
