The board discussed that there was not enough information.

The five factors were reviewed: There would be no undesirable change in the character of the neighborhood; benefit sought could be achieved by another method; variance is not substantial; there may or may not be an adverse impact on the physical or environmental conditions in the neighborhood; difficulty is self-created

Roll Vote: Santovito – yes; McEwen – yes; Frey – yes; Jeffries – yes. Therefore, this variance was denied.
